ecomax by HOBART convinces with more economical models

Offenburg, October 29, 2024 – Lower consumption, efficient washing programs, and intuitive operation – and all of these benefits at a very reasonable price: In keeping with its motto "Low price, high performance, the warewashing manufacturer HOBART further optimised most of the models of its entry-level brand ecomax. It also developed one new model that make dishwashing in the professional kitchen even more efficient and easy. The robust, reliable dishwashers offer commercial kitchen designers, restaurateurs, hotel managers and food service providers an affordable alternative to HOBART's premium solutions. They will be available from 1st November. The world market leader in commercial warewashing guarantees perfect hygiene and equipment to rely on - even for the ecomax budget range.

ecomax Plus: New model in the portfolio

One model is new in the ecomax Plus portfolio: the extra-deep undercounter dishwasher F515 L. Offering a number of practical functions as well as an extra-deep wash chamber that receives Euronorm trays, boxes and containers of 600 x 400 mm, the **dishwasher F515 L** is the perfect choice for coffee shops, fast-food restaurants, bakeries and butcher shops with food counters.

Update of the existing ecomax Plus models

In addition to many other functions, the optimised **glasswasher model G415** and **dishwasher model F515** are equipped with a new washing program for spotlessly clean cutlery. Besides, the **F515** convinces with two additional washing programs, one for glasses and one for bottles and reusable cups. The bottle washing program comprises a spray attachment, wire attachment, and bottle rack and ensures hygienically perfect cleaning of all types of bottles. All ecomax Plus undercounter dishwashers feature a new ergonomic door handle for improved ease of use.

Significantly more efficient than their predecessor models

In general, all optimised ecomax models require less water, energy, and chemicals. The per-rack consumption of the glasswashers, for example, has been reduced from 2.0 litres to now only 1.8 litres. Also the Offenburg-based specialist for commercial warewashing managed to reduce the water consumption from 2.3 litres to now 2.0 litres per wash cycle for the undercounter dishwashers.

By default, all ecomax models have three wash programs for various degrees of soiling to ensure fast and efficient cleaning of any type of washware. Optionally, suction lances are available for all models for accurate dosing of detergent and rinse aid, ensuring perfect washing results with lower consumption.

Further functions for an easier workday

The single-button control and a colour-coded status message make the commercial warewashers easy and intuitive to operate. A partial or full-surface double wall, depending on the model, ensures better heat and sound insulation of the washing chamber and therefore perfect temperature conditions in the scullery.
